Here is the latest as of September 3rd:

Both the FDA and CDC have approved and recommended the first **updated** Covid vaccines to be given as boosters. These updated shots are bivalent vaccines, meaning they protect against both the original strain of the virus and the Omicron variants BA.4 and BA.5.

Those eligible for a single booster dose of either of these updated, bivalent vaccines are as follows:

- Individuals 18 years of age and older are eligible for a single booster dose of Moderna's new shot if it has been at least 2 months since their final dose or booster of the primary series of any approved monovalent vaccine
- Individuals 12 years of age and older are eligible for a single booster dose of Pfizer's new bivalent vaccine if it has been at least 2 months since their final dose or booster of the primary series of any approved monovalent vaccine

Just to clarify, only those who have received prior Covid shots should receive this booster – and are eligible 2 months after their most recent shot. The primary, monovalent vaccines are still available for those with no Covid vaccination history
